The following are good suggestions for our donations:

New baby items such as diapers, toys, clothes...

New activity or sticker books, pencils, pens, crayons

New small electric handheld toys...

New stuffed animals, Beanie babies...

New Barbie dolls, trucks...

*Note: Please do not send any small items that can be swallowed and/or messy activities. Children are not allowed to use these before or after surgery. Ages range from infants through high schoolers.

We will be putting baskets together as a grade level. Our room parents and volunteers will assist the fourth grade students with organizing baskets and making gift tags.
